
The Wire is our community platform designed exclusively for Future Space and wider Oxford Innovation Space businesses and trusted partners.

Recycling

Please recycle as much as you can. You can put a small amount of broken-down cardboard by your recycling bin to be collected by the cleaners. However, if you've had a large delivery, please take excessive amounts of cardboard out to the recycling bins in the bin area. The bins are located at the top of the Future Space car park near the green gates.

Toilets and showers

There are various sets of toilets around the building, including disabled toilets. The main toilets can be found by the meeting rooms and on other side of the Café in the hub. We also have showers available for you, but please do not leave any personal items in these. We will provide you with a map of the site to help orientate you.

Cleaning

All our communal areas and office space are cleaned by a dedicated team of external cleaners. If you have any concerns, please do let us know.

Smoking

Like all buildings nowadays, there is no smoking inside Future Space. There is, however, an outdoor ashtray at the reception entrance for you to use should you need it. Please ensure vaping is kept to outside the building.

Fire alarms

UWE test the alarms on the third Tuesday of every month. The tests are usually carried out at 9.40am or 2.40pm. Whilst the test is being carried out you do not need to go anywhere (the test will only sound for a few seconds). However, if there is a real emergency, the alarm will sound continually and the red sirens in the corridors will flash continually please evacuate to car park 21 and have your fire marshal report to one of our reception staff or Fire wardens.

First aid

You are responsible for any accident or incidents involving your own staff and should risk assess first aid provision. If an accident occurs on site, please report this to reception, so that an accident form can be completed.
